Subject: Composition of the Planning Committee of Space Applications Management System
(SAMS) and the Ten Standing Committees to address the requirements of satellites

& associated ground segment and its optimal utilisation – reg.

1. Preamble

The erstwhile National Natural Resources Management System (NNRMS) was established in 1985, as a well-knit network involving Central & State Governments, Private sectors, Academia and Non-Governmental Organizations for enabling the integration of Remote Sensing, contemporary technologies with the conventional practices for management of natural resources. The NNRMS framework included a Planning Committee of NNRMS (PC-NNRMS) chaired by Member (Science), Planning Commission and Secretaries of various Ministries/ Departments as Members. It was supported by nine theme oriented Standing Committees, namely - i) Agriculture & Soils (SC-A), ii) Bioresources (SC-B), iii) Cartography & Mapping (SC-C), iv) Geology & Mineral resources (SC-G), v) Oceanography & Meteorology (SC-OM), vi) Rural Development (SC-R), vii) Urban Development (SC-U), viii) Water Resources (SC-W), ix) Training & Technology (SC-T). These SCs were working on behalf of PC-NNRMS, and responsible for utilization of space technology applications in respective areas.

In addition to natural resources management, space technology applications are proliferating in other areas, viz., infrastructure planning, governance & development, location-based services, societal communication, disaster risk reduction etc. This necessitates synergistic use of earth observation, communication, navigation satellites with other technologies and ensuring its effective adoption by stakeholder departments for operational use.

Considering the above, erstwhile NNRMS is restructured as Space Applications Management System (SAMS) with enhanced scope to dwell on need aspect of satellite missions and associated ground segment, development of applications aligned with national imperatives, and their optimal utilization to harness the benefits of space-based services.

The SAMS framework comprises of a Planning Committee of SAMS (PC-SAMS), supported by ten theme specific Standing Committees (SCs). PC-SAMS, as the apex-body, is empowered to oversee the SAMS activities, provide policy guidelines and endorse fund requirements for implementation of space applications. The Standing Committees, on behalf of PC-SAMS, shall identify thrust areas, data & application needs and mechanism to ensure maximal utilization of space technology in respective thematic areas. The Standing Committees shall inform its recommendations to PC-SAMS for

implementation.

PC-SAMS will be chaired by Principal Scientific Adviser to Government of India, with Secretaries and senior officials of the User Ministries/Department as Members. The Standing Committees will be chaired by the Secretaries to the Government of India.

The Secretariat of PC-SAMS will be located at Earth observation applications & Disaster management support Programme Office (EDPO), ISRO HQ., Bangalore. Director, EDPO will serve as the Secretary of PC-SAMS.

Terms of Reference (TOR) of PC-SAMS:

- PC-SAMS shall ensure the interaction among various user departments, through its theme specific Standing Committees, for identifying the requirements of space-based services.
- · PC-SAMS shall recommend necessary space technology interventions and provide justification for its

implementation.

- PC-SAMS shall recommend the suitable funding mechanism to realize space assets and associated ground segment through designated PSU/CPSE under DOS or directly by DOS.
- PC-SAMS shall oversee the utilization of space-based services for the benefit of the governance and development.

3.SAMS Standing Committees (SCs):

The ten-theme based Standing Committees (SCs) are constituted in the areas of - i) Agriculture & Soils (SC-A&S), ii) Bio-resources & Environment (SC-B&E), iii) Geosciences (SC-G), iv) Oceanography & Meteorology (SC-O&M), v) Rural & Panchayat Development (SC-R&P), vi) State/UT Development (SC-S&U), vii) Urban & Cartography (SC-U&C), viii) Water Resources (SC-W), ix) Disaster Management (SC-DM), x) Societal Communication & Navigation (SC-C&N).

The Standing Committees shall work, on behalf of PC-SAMS, and shall be primarily responsible for identifying user requirements for space-based services, thrust areas of applications, proof of concept studies and their plan for utilization and operationalization in respective thematic areas.

Terms of Reference (TOR) of all the Standing Committees:

- SCs shall assess the current capabilities, identify gaps and thrust areas in space applications.
- SCs shall evaluate theme specific needs and arrive at suitable specifications for building satellite systems.
- SCs shall identify required techniques of data analysis, modelling, data integration, information system and mechanism to ensure data utilization.
- SCs shall formulate programs / projects aligned with the developmental needs and also suggest sources of funding for implementation.
- SCs shall present its recommendations to PC-SAMS for implementation.
