GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES REGARDING WRITTEN EXAMINATION.

- 1. Candidates won't be allowed to enter the venue after 10:30 AM
- 2. Candidate Should wear the Mask at all times. Entry without wearing mask shall not be permitted.
- 3. Candidates should bring blue ball point pen in the examination hall for making the answer sheet.
- 4. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates appearing for the written test.
- 5. Calculators / Mobile phones / smart watches / any other communication or Bluetooth devices either in working or switched off mode will not be allowed in the examination Hall.
- 6. Candidate must bring One ID Proof Driving License / Passport / Govt. issued IDcard (preferably Aadhaar Card) and a passport photo (same as pasted on application form)with him/her to secure Admission to the examination hall/room.
